FY 2019 Agawam Community Development Fund Application

The Agawam City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on **Monday, February 4, 2019 at 7:00 PM** at the Agawam Junior High School auditorium, 1305 Springfield Street, Feeding Hills, MA. In the event of a weather cancelation, the meeting will occur at the next scheduled Council meeting on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at the same time and location. The purpose of the hearing will be to discuss the town's proposed FY19 Community Development Block Program application (TR-2018-106). The application will be filed no later than March 1, 2019. The Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (PVPC) is assisting the city with this application.

Residents are encouraged to attend this meeting to discuss the FY19 application to the MA Department of Housing and Community Development for up to \$550,250 in available Community Development Block Grant Funds. All persons with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. Those unable to attend can send written comments to the Office of Planning and Community Development, Town Hall – 36 Main Street, Agawam, MA 01001, Attn: Marc Strange, Planning and Community Development Director.

Projects currently being discussed include roof replacement at the Agawam Housing Authority's Brady Village complex and a comprehensive infrastructure planning study in the North Agawam section of the city.

The Agawam Junior High School Auditorium is handicapped accessible.
