### AGAWAM WATER DEPARTMENT – CONNECTION AND SERVICE CHARGES

The Department of Public Works hereby announces that effective April 3, 2017 the following changes are effective for various water services provided by the Department of Public Works.

#### WATER METERS - (New Accounts Only)

5/8" Meter	\$410.00	2" Turbo Meter	\$1,460.00
3/4" Meter	\$425.00	1 1/2" Compound Turbo Meter	\$1,665.00
1" Meter	\$480.00	2" Compound Turbo Meter	\$1,900.00
1 1/2" Turbo Meter	\$1,255.00		

Any meter upgraded shall be charged the time and materials required at the current rates. The DPW reserves the right to replace meters based on the current flow demand and the meter sizing according to AWWA M22.

Any meter or part of meter reading system (meter, wire, touchpad, radioread MXU) that is allowed to be damaged shall be charged to the owner at the current time and materials rate.

WATER MAIN DRILLING & TAPPING      3/4" or 1" Service      \$330.00

FINAL WATER/SEWER READING AND CALCULATION      \$25.00 (per property)

TURN OFF OR ON WATER AT CURB      \$45.00

(Overtime requests will be billed at the actual OT rates)

REMOVAL OR REINSTALLATION OF WATER METERS      \$87.50

#### CROSS CONNECTION FEES

- A fee of \$67.50 for application review and permitting of backflow prevention devices.
- A fee of \$40.00 for the required testing of backflow prevention device.
