1. Case # 1810, Six Flags New England

Chairwoman Prouty opened this public meeting at 8:35 AM.

Chairwoman Prouty called the meeting due to an event that occurred over the past few days. Gary Suffriti and Jim Marmo visited Six Flags on Friday, February 15, 2008 and discovered a substantial portion of the indoor rollercoaster had been built without the required permits.

Chairwoman Prouty indicated that she was notified by Jennifer Bonfiglio of a stop work order drafted by Jim Marmo. Chairwoman Prouty advised there were some mistakes in the letter and she called this meeting to discuss it further. Chairwoman Prouty also advised that after this meeting was posted, the Building Inspector issued a Stop order. A copy of the letter was distributed to all members by Chairwoman Prouty. Mr. Gary Shannon requested a copy of the letter.

Joe Conte asked what this has to do with the Board of Appeals. Ms. Prouty advised that because a letter was initially drafted by a Board of Appeals member, she called for this meeting. Joe Conte also stated the Board of Appeals issued their decision on February 14, 2008 and feels that the Board has done their job and he feels that it is now in the hands of the Building Inspector.

Jim Marmo stated that he is now satisfied with the Stop Order.

Gary Suffriti advised that the reason they visited Six Flags was that he received an anonymous phone calls. He and called Chuck Davis from Six Flags and received approval to view the site. Since he and Jim Marmo visited Six Flags and the Stop Order was issued, Six Flags has been in compliance. He also stated that they do not wish to hold up Six Flags any further. It is now between Six Flags and the Building Inspector.

The Board is satisfied with the letter sent by the Building Inspector.

There is no other discussion.
