

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE MASSACHUSETTS  
DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND RECREATION TO THE TOWN OF  
AGAWAM FOR TRAIL DEVELOPMENT PURSUANT TO MASSACHUSETTS  
GENERAL LAWS CHAPTER 44, SECTION 53A**

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth's Department of Conservation and Recreation ("DCR") has awarded the Town of Agawam a grant to create and improve walking and hiking trails included in the Tuckahoe Farm master plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant is in the amount of fifty thousand dollars and zero cents (\$50,000.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town received notice of the award several months ago but has been awaiting a contract for the grant along with authorization on all the funding to develop the parcels; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of the grant has been contemplated with the final tabulation of costs for the project and the acceptance does not alter the amount necessary to be borrowed for full funding of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the Town of Agawam to accept said grant.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Agawam City Council pursuant to M.G.L. c. 44 §53A accepts a grant in the amount of fifty thousand dollars and zero cents (\$50,000.00) from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation for walking and hiking trails at the parcels known as Tuckahoe.
