

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FROM THE COMMUNITY PRESERVATION FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF COMMUNITY PRESERVATION FUNDS FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE AGAWAM SKATE PARK

Sponsored by the Community Preservation Act Committee

Whereas, voters of Agawam chose to form a Community Preservation Committee (CPA); and

Whereas, pursuant to Massachusetts General Law Chapter 44B, Section 5(2) allows the CPA Committee to make recommendations to the legislative body; and

Whereas, pursuant to Massachusetts General Law Chapter 44B, Section 5(3)(d) states that the legislative body shall then take such action and approve such appropriations for the CPA Committee; and

Whereas, one of the CPA committee's functions is related to providing recreation benefits to the Town and its residents;

Whereas, the expenditure will allow the Town to rehabilitate the existing skate park on land owned by the Town of Agawam and located at Shea Field;

Whereas, The City Council previously appropriated one hundred thirty thousand seven hundred dollars and no cents (\$130,700.00) from the CPA fund balance for the Agawam Skate Park; and

Whereas, the previous appropriation is not sufficient to cover the actual expenses upon completion of bidding;

Whereas, the increased costs are primarily due to overages from bidding compared to those estimated using the Town's 2021-2022 paving contract;

Whereas, The Community Preservation Committee has recommended an additional appropriation and expenditure in the amount of thirty-nine thousand ninety-six dollars and no cents (\$39,096) from the budgeted reserve fund balance; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE AGAWAM CITY COUNCIL hereby further resolves, appropriates and authorizes the expenditure of Community Preservation Funds in the amount of thirty-nine thousand ninety-six dollars and no cents (\$39,096) from the budgeted reserve fund balance for the rehabilitation of the Agawam Skate Park Field in accordance with M.G.L. Ch. 44b, Sec. 2.

THE AGAWAM CITY COUNCIL hereby further resolves that the Mayor is authorized to expend said funds, as permitted by law, and to do all things necessary for the purposes so stated.


