**A RESOLUTION NAMING THE PARK PROPERTY OWNED BY
THE CITY OF AGAWAM LOCATED BETWEEN PINE STREET
AND SOUTH WEST STREET AS STILL BROOK PARK**

WHEREAS, the City of Agawam is currently working on the construction and creation of a new park on the former “Tuckahoe Turf Farm” property which is located between Pine Street and South West Street in Feeding Hills;

WHEREAS, the new park will include recreational opportunities for residents of Agawam and Feeding Hills;

WHEREAS, the City of Agawam is desirous of naming the new park as it is time in the construction process where signage needs to be ordered;

WHEREAS, the land that comprises the new park was utilized for agricultural purposes from the early 1800's until the time the city began development of the property as a park;

WHEREAS, Still Brook flows across the new park from the northwest to the southeast, and once powered a grist mill on South West Street;

WHEREAS, given the strong agricultural heritage of the land that comprises the new park, it seems fitting to name the park in honor of Still Brook;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Agawam to name the new park on the former “Tuckahoe Turf Farm” property which is located between Pine Street and South West Street in Feeding Hills as Still Brook Park; and


