Mr. Kozloski called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

1. 6:00PM PUBLIC HEARING-Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation-311 Shoemaker Lane-Ameresco, Inc

David Cameron, Fleetwood Environmental Solutions, LLC was present for this agenda item. He stated the subject parcel was exclusively a corn field that predated the Wetlands Protection Act and has been an agricultural field for many decades. He stated that in September and October of 2025 Fleetwood conducted a visual inspection of the site and this included a meandered survey throughout the parcel. They also conducted desktop evaluations of maps and historical aerial images and related resources. He stated prior to this in 2015 and 2016 the owner retained GZA to conduct natural resource evaluations, including a stream flow assessment for a small stream west of the parcel. He went on to say there is a man-made ditch along the eastern and southern portions of the parcel which delineated a Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW), and another BVW was located on the western portion, where there is also a bank and an intermittent stream, which indicates a 100ft. buffer zone. During the period of evaluation it was determined there was no flow to the stream.

Mr. Kozloski stated the DEP has recommended a peer review and that an ANRAD was submitted for this property in 2021 and a peer review was conducted at that time, and the application was withdrawn. The Commission discussed having a peer review done.

Motion was made by Mr. Meagher and seconded by Ms. Becker to require a peer review to delineate the wetland, for 311 Shoemaker Lane.
