### LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

The Agawam Liquor License held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, April 20, 2022 at the Agawam Senior Center, 954 Main St., Agawam, MA. Kenneth Largay, Chairman, Vincenzo Ronghi, Commissioner and Margaret McCarthy, Secretary, were present.

Discussion was held with Frank DiBenedetto from Siana, Inc. dba Take Five Restaurant, 944 Springfield St., Feeding Hills to file an alteration of premises. Take Five has an existing patio and the Commissioners would like to see this area permanently licensed for serving alcohol. Mr. DiBenedetto submitted the paperwork, his public hearing will be planned for our next meeting, May 18, 2022.

Casa di Lisa did not attend this meeting to discuss their alteration of premises for a permanent patio.

A vote was taken for an outdoor dining extension (4/1/2023), this was approved unanimously and will allow anyone who applies to be granted a liquor license, as long as they have a permit from the Building Inspector. Serving will stop outdoors at 10:00 p.m.
