### LIQUOR LICENSE MEETING MINUTES

The Agawam Liquor License Commission held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, September 22, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. at the Agawam Senior Center, 954 Main St., Agawam, MA.

A public hearing was held for an incident at The Riverboat Bar & Grill, 11 South End Bridge Circle, Agawam, on August 28, 2021. Sergeant Christopher Soto read his incident report and the Commissioners applaud his actions and professionalism in dealing with the situation. Attorney Daniel Kelly was in attendance to represent the Riverboat as well as Alice Fusco, manager, Sueann Begin, bartender, and several family and staff members. The Riverboat has been in good standing for decades with their liquor license and no problems. Discussion was held regarding the incident and the woman served has been trespassed from the establishment. Although the patron did not appear to the bartender as being intoxicated Sgt. Soto's report led to the Commissioner's decision. The board unanimously voted to suspend their license for a total of three (3) days, to be held in abeyance for twelve (12) months. (Violation: MGL Ch. 138, section 69 – sale or delivery to an intoxicated person).

A discussion was to be held with Carmella Craig from "Catch 1251" regarding the status of her license but she did not appear.

Applications for one-day liquor licenses at "Rovi Homes", 11 Herbert P. Almgren Dr., (10/16/21) and "The Captain Charles Leonard House", 663 Main St., (10/08/21) were approved unanimously.

Discussion was held to contact Casa di Lisa, Partners and Take Five to apply for "alteration of premises" on their licenses to include their patios.
