

STILL BROOK PARK - Feeding Hills, MA



Welcome to Still Brook Park - a 216.0 Acre park located at 100 Pine Street in Feeding Hills, Massachusetts. This expansive outdoor passive recreation area offers a diverse range of activities for visitors to enjoy. Formerly the Tuckahoe Turf Farm, the town-owned property has been transformed into a vibrant public park after many years of planning and development. This project includes the state-mandated restoration of the Nine Lot Dam which impounds a pond on the property. The \$6.3 million project was funded through multiple sources including the Massachusetts Trails Grant, the Parkland Acquisitions and Renovations for Community Grant, Community Preservation Act Funds, corporate donations, and solar lease payments.

PARK INFORMATION

Still Brook park includes new walking, biking, and hiking trails, as well as facilities for canoeing, kayaking, picnicking, and fishing. Additional amenities include information kiosks, educational signage, a pavilion, trail markers, benches, picnic tables, bike racks, and a scenic overlook. Additional improvements are planned for the coming years to further enhance the overall experience.

Activities: hiking/biking, fishing, canoe/kayak, observation areas, educational signs, birding/wildlife viewing, picnics, passive activities in open field.

Park hours: open dawn until dusk. Town may close the park at any time. Use at your own risk. Some hiking trails are not ADA accessible or currently maintained by the Town. Be aware of ticks in wooded and tall grass areas.

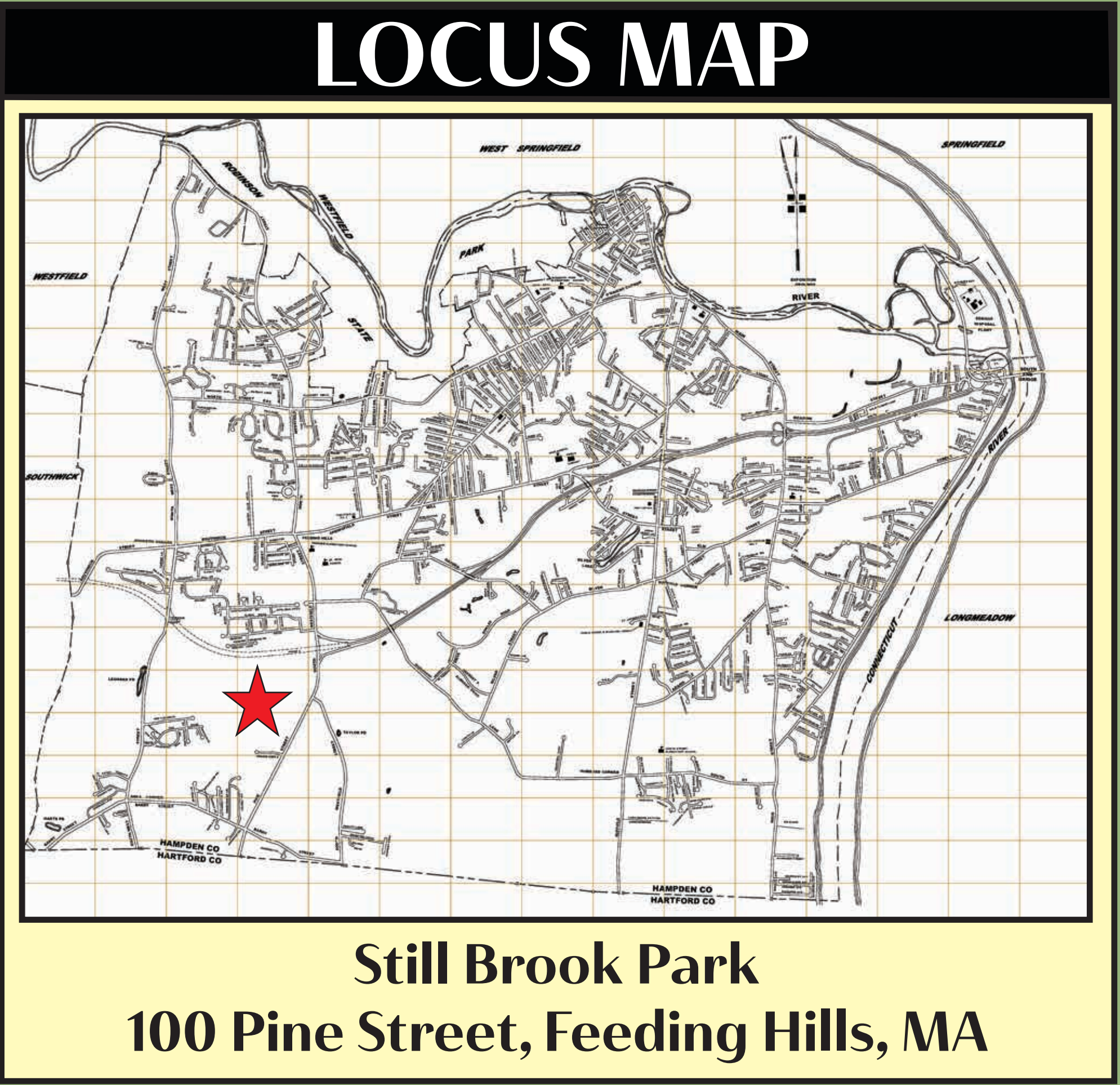
No Hunting/trapping. Catch and release only from pond. No motorized vehicles on gravel paths or trails. No motorized boats. No swimming/wading. No alcohol. No smoking/vaping. No fires/BBQs. No fireworks. No camping or overnight parking. No littering. No horses. No cutting of trees, flowers, etc. No removal of material or digging. No loud music. Please stay on established paths and trails. Do not trespass on private property or solar fields.

Dogs must remain on a leash at all times. Please pick up after your dogs to help keep this park clean. Thank you.
