Refunds

If a program is cancelled by the Recreation Department, a full refund will be given. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all refunds due to participant cancellation. If a program fee is \$50.00 or less 50% of the program fee will be refunded.

Bounced Check Fees

The Town of Agawam will impose a \$25.00 fee on checks or online payments returned due to insufficient funds.

Online Registration

Park and Recreation will make programs available for online registration and walk in registrations will still be accepted. Enrollment for all programs is limited on a first come first serve basis. **Please check the registration section of each program to see if online registration is available.**

Insurance

The Town of Agawam does not carry insurance to cover medical costs or hospitalization for anyone injured in or watching any of our Parks and Recreation programs. Program participants must sign a grant of permission and release waiver to participate in Recreation Department sponsored activities.
